Remember, being a member of the National Honor Society is a privilege, not a right. It takes time and dedication! Below is a summary of the requirements listed in the chapter By-Laws that must be met to maintain active membership.

### 1.) GPA

All members of National Honor Society must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.6 or higher.

• Members of the class of 2020 are held to the conditions of their induction: 3.4 or higher

### 2.) Character

Members must demonstrate positive character inside and outside of school. Any disciplinary actions could lead to probation and/or dismissal.

## 3.) Community Service

Each quarter, members must complete community service volunteer hours. All community service hours must come from the approved list found on the NHS website or approved by the advisors BEFORE the service is performed to confirm it will be counted. The 2019 - 2020 required hours are: 5 hours per quarter

If you are submitting an activity for review, please keep the following in mind. Volunteer hours should:

- Never be paid for
- Not include NHS events
- Not counted for another organization (e.g. work performed to earn an Eagle Scout award may not also count towards NHS hours, volunteer work mandated by your sports team may not also count toward NHS hours.)

### 4.) Leadership Project (Seniors only)

This project must be significant in size and provide the member with an opportunity to demonstrate leadership and community service. Please see the rubric for details and the calendar for deadlines.

# 5.) Attendance: General Membership Meetings

Attendance is mandatory at all general membership meetings. See Appendix A for dates.

# 6.) Participation: Chapter Events

Participation is mandatory for all Chapter Events. To differentiate the various needs of our members, when possible, we have provided participation options, which allows members to find ways to participate in a manner that fits their interests and personal schedule. Your attendance and participation is essential to the success of the chapter and any absence you accrue, for any reason, creates a burden on the other members who must complete not only their portion of responsibilities, but yours as well.
